ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 6th day of December 1976

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 123 and 125 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Miscellaneous) Amendment Order 1976.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Tariff amended—(1) The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

(2) The Second Schedule of the Customs Tariff (Generalised System of Preferences) Amendment Order 1976† is hereby amended in the manner indicated in the Third Schedule hereto.

3. Consequential revocations—(1) The Customs Tariff (Prepared or Preserved Fish) Amendment Order 1976* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to item 16.04.017.

(2) The Customs Tariff (Generalised System of Preferences) Amendment Order 1976† is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to items 38.09.009, 70.04.003, and 73.15.321.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order makes miscellaneous alterations to the Customs Tariff.

The Second Schedule amends various items within various Tariff Headings, viz:

- (a) Heading 16.04—Item 16.04.017 has been amended to include “saury”. This amendment was the result of a recommendation made by the Industries Development Commission.
- (b) Heading 27.10—The text of two items within this heading is altered so as to conform with international standards in the volume calculation of lubricating oils.
- (c) Heading 38.09—This amendment corrects an error in the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1974 relating to the “unit for duty”.
- (d) Heading 70.04—Amendment is made reclassifying “Float Glass” within heading 70.06 in line with a Brussels Customs Co-Operation Council Nomenclature Committee decision.
- (e) Heading 73.15—A printing error in the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1974 is corrected in that Tariff Item 73.15.312 has been amended to read 73.15.321.

The Third Schedule corrects minor errors in the Customs Tariff (Generalised System of Preferences) Amendment Order 1976.
