PURSUANT to sections 123 and 124 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Miscellaneous) Amendment Order 1983.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Tariff amended**—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking so much of Part I as relates to items 20.06.061, 20.06.071, 20.06.081, 20.06.089, 39.01.339, 39.02.309, 39.02.311, 39.02.312, 39.02.319, 39.02.329, 39.05.108, 39.07.309, 40.08.001, 40.08.011, 48.12.001, 48.12.009, 49.08.000, 59.02.012, 59.10.001, 59.10.009, 60.06.021, and 60.06.029, and substituting the items, rates of duty, exemptions from duty, and statistical key specified in the Schedule to this order.

**3. Consequential revocations**—(1) The Customs Tariff (Developing Country) Amendment Order 1979\* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Fourth Schedule as relates to item 40.08.011.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order amends the rates of Customs duty on certain canned fruits of heading 20.06 and resins of heading 39.05; and corrects duty rates for Australia for headings 49.08, 59.02, and 60.06. It further amends the rates on resilient flooring falling within Chapter 39 and headings 40.08, 48.12, and 59.10.

The amendments result from decisions by the Government on recommendations made by the Industries Development Commission, subsequent adjustment under the Plastics Industry Development Plan, and corrections to duty-phasing under the Australia - New Zealand Closer Economic Relations Trade Agreement.
