PURSUANT to sections 123 and 124 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Salt) Amendment Order 1984.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking so much of Part I as relates to items 25.01.001, 25.01.005, 25.01.009, 25.01.011, and 25.01.019, and substituting the items, rates of duty, exemptions from duty, and statistical key specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. Revocations—The Customs Tariff (Sparteca) Amendment Order 1980* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Fourth Schedule as relates to items 25.01.009 and 25.01.011.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order restructures salt of heading 25.01, and increases the rates of duty on rock salt other than crude lumps. The increases result from the Tariff Review Committee and are based on a previous Tariff and Development Board's report in 1975.
