

# THE CUSTOMS TARIFF (ANZCERTA) AMENDMENT ORDER 1984

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of September 1984

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to section 125 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the
Governor General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the
Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Anzcerta) Amendment Order 1984.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking so much of Part I as relates to the rates of duty specified after the expression "Aul" in the column of the Customs Tariff headed "Preferential Tariff", in respect of Tariff items 40.11.041 and 40.11.048, and substituting in each case the rate of duty "15".
- **3. Consequential revocations**—The Customs Tariff (Tyres) Amendment Order 1983\* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Schedule as relates to the "Aul" rates of duty for items 40.11.041 and 40.11.048.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order reduces the Australian rate of duty on certain tyres and tyre cases of heading 40.11 of the Tariff. These amendments result from consultations with Australia in relation to CER.
