**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 4th day of April 1966

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Customs Amendment Act 1921 and sections 5 and 6 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the rates of duty and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, being rates and exemptions specified in the Customs Tariff (as set out in the First Schedule to the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961 and heretofore modified) are likely to operate in an injurious, unfair, or anomalous manner generally to the public interest, hereby makes the following order.

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**ORDER**

**1.** (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 2) 1966.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2.** The portions of the Customs Tariff specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby suspended.

**3.** The duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed, and the exemptions from duty in that Schedule are hereby created.

**4.** The Tariff is hereby amended in the manner indicated in the Third Schedule hereto.

**5.** The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 3) 1962\* is hereby consequentially amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to Group 654, and so much of the Third Schedule as relates to Group 654 and Group 656.

**6.** This order shall be in force in Niue.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

So far as it relates to Tariff item 695.260.0, this order reduces the Most Favoured Nation rate of duty from 20% to 10%. The other amendments made by the order merely subdivide Tariff items 654.030.0 and 655.500.0 for statistical purposes, without altering rates of duty.
