ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 10th day of May 1967

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 123 and 124 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the rates of duty and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, being rates and exemptions specified in the Customs Tariff (as set out in the Second Schedule to the Customs Act 1966) are likely to operate in an injurious, unfair, or anomalous manner either generally to the public interest or particularly to certain industries or businesses carried on in New Zealand, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 2) 1967.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1967.

2. The portions of the Customs Tariff specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby suspended.

3. The duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed, and the exemptions from duty in that Schedule are hereby created.

4. The Tariff is hereby amended in the manner indicated in the Third Schedule hereto.

5. The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 4) 1966*, the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order 1966†, and the Customs Tariff Amendment Order 1967‡ are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order amends the new Customs Tariff as set out in the Second Schedule to the Customs Act 1966 and comes into force on 1 July 1967, so that the Tariff will operate as amended by the order.

The Second Schedule translates into the new Tariff the higher rates of duty on certain fabrics containing wool or man-made discontinuous fibres, and the lower rates of duty on road graders and Australian frozen peas and beans, which have since been brought into force in the present Tariff by the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 4) 1966, the Customs Tariff Amendment Order 1967, and the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order 1966. It also effects alterations to the duties payable on hinges under heading 83.02, subdivides certain items for statistical purposes without altering rates of duty, and corrects drafting errors and omissions in the new Tariff.

The Third Schedule corrects an omission from Interpretative Rule (3), effects amendments made by the Customs Co-operation Council to notes in the Brussels Nomenclature, inserts a new note to Chapter 59, clarifies the scope of a subheading under heading 83.01, and varies certain statistical units.
