ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 19th day of June 1984

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to sections 123 and 124 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency
the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the
Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Packing) Amendment Order (No. 2) 1984.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 20th day of June 1984.

2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking so much of Part I as relates to items 03.01.017, 03.01.029, 03.03.011, 03.03.021, 07.05.001, 07.05.011, 11.01.011, 11.01.021, 15.04.059, 15.07.031, 15.07.041, 15.07.051, 15.07.059, 15.08.011, 15.08.021, 15.08.029, 21.03.001, 21.03.009, 21.03.011, 21.03.019, 28.17.001, 28.17.005, 28.17.009, 32.09.041, and 32.09.049, and substituting the items, rates of duty, exemptions from duty, and statistical key specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. Revocations—(1) The Customs Tariff (Developing Country) Amendment Order 1979* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Fourth Schedule as relates to items 03.03.011 and 03.03.021.

(2) The Customs Tariff (SPARTECA) Amendment Order 1980† is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Fourth Schedule as relates to items 03.01.017, 03.01.029, 03.03.011, 03.03.021, 07.05.001, 07.05.011, 11.01.011, 11.01.021, 15.04.059, 15.07.041, 15.07.059, 15.08.021, 15.08.029, 21.03.001, 21.03.009, 21.03.011, 21.03.019, 28.17.001, 32.09.041, and 32.09.049.

(3) The Customs Tariff (Miscellaneous) Amendment Order 1981‡ is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Fifth Schedule as relates to items 32.09.041 and 32.09.049.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 20 June 1984, reinstates in the Customs Tariff the items, rates of duty, exemptions from duty, and statistical key applicable under the Customs Tariff (Packing) Amendment Order 1984. That order expired on the close of 14 June 1984 (the last day of the session in which it was laid before Parliament). For that order to have continued in force, an Act of Parliament validating or confirming it would need to have been passed during that session.

Section 131 (3) of the Customs Act 1966 requires that any duty, which has been collected under the expired order and which is in excess of the duty otherwise payable, is to be refunded.
