ORDER (NO. 2) 1985**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 123, 124, and 125 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Miscellaneous) Amendment Order (No. 2) 1985.

(2) Subject to subclause (3) of this clause, this order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1985.

(3) Clause 3 of this order shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1985.

2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking so much of Part I as relates to items 58.01.002, 58.01.005, 58.01.009, 58.02.041, 58.02.051, 58.02.059, 58.02.061, 58.02.071, 58.02.079, 87.06.131, 87.06.141, 87.06.151, 87.06.161, 87.06.171, 87.06.181, 87.06.189, 89.01.025, 89.01.029, 89.02.009, 89.03.009, and 89.05.009, and substituting the items, rates of duty, exemptions from duty, and statistical key specified in the First Schedule hereto.

3. Additional amendment of Customs Tariff—(1) The Customs Tariff is hereby further amended by inserting a new Section Note 9 to Section XI, as set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

(2) The Customs Tariff is hereby further amended by revoking Legal Note 3 to Chapter 22.

4. Consequential revocations—(1) The Customs Tariff (Textile) Amendment Order 1980* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Schedule as relates to items 58.01.001 and 58.01.009.

(2) The Customs Tariff (Sparteca) Amendment Order 1980† is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Fourth Schedule as relates to items 58.01.001 and 58.01.009.

(3) The Customs Tariff (Ships and Boats) Amendment Order 1981‡ is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Schedule as relates to items 89.01.025, 89.01.029, 89.02.009, 89.03.009, and 89.05.009.

(4) The Customs Tariff (Motor Vehicle) Amendment Order 1984§ is hereby amended by revoking so much of the First Schedule as relates to items 58.02.041, 58.02.051, 58.02.059, 58.02.061, 58.02.071, 58.02.079, 87.06.141, 87.06.151, 87.06.161, 87.06.171, 87.06.181, and 87.06.189.

(5) The Customs Tariff (Miscellaneous) Amendment Order 1985|| is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Schedule as relates to item 87.06.131.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order—

- (a) Amends the structure and various rates of duty on carpets of Chapter 58 as a result of recommendations made by the Industries Development Commission;
- (b) Amends certain rates of duty for motor vehicles of Chapter 87 to account for Australian preferences;
- (c) Amends various rates of duty on ships and boats of Chapter 89 in accordance with recommendations made by the Industries Development Commission;
- (d) Creates a new note to Section XI to assist in the classification of goods in sets;
- (e) Deletes Legal Note 3 to Chapter 22.
