**THE CUSTOMS TARIFF (PAPER) AMENDMENT ORDER (NO. 2)
1987**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 13th day of July 1987

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 123 and 124 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the rates of duty specified in items 48.01.019 and 48.01.129 of the Customs Tariff are likely to operate in an injurious, unfair, or anomalous manner generally to the public interest and particularly to certain industries carried out in New Zealand, and that it is necessary for the protection of those industries that the duties set out in the Schedule hereto should be imposed, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Paper) Amendment Order (No. 2) 1987.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1987.

2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking so much of Part I as relates to items 48.01.011, 48.01.013, 48.01.017, 48.01.019, 48.01.121, and 48.01.129, and substituting the items, rates of duty, exemptions from duty, and statistical keys specified in the Schedule to this order.

3. Consequential revocations—(1) The Customs Tariff (SPARTECA) Amendment Order 1980 (S.R. 1980/248) is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Fourth Schedule as relates to items 48.01.011, 48.01.013, 48.01.017, 48.01.019, 48.01.121, and 48.01.129.

(2) The Customs Tariff (Miscellaneous) Amendment Order 1986 (S.R. 1986/125) is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Fourth Schedule as relates to items 48.01.011, 48.01.013, 48.01.017, 48.01.019, 48.01.121, and 48.01.129.

(3) The Customs Tariff (Miscellaneous) Amendment Order 1986 (S.R. 1986/125) is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Fifth Schedule as relates to item 48.01.121.
