## THE GUSTOMS TARIFF AMENDMENT ORDER (NO. 3) 1962

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of June 1962
Present:
His Excellency the Governor-General in Council
Pursuant to section 12 of the Customs Amendment Act 1921 and section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the duties specified in the Customs Tariff (as set out in the First Schedule to the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961 and amended by the Customs Tariff Amendment Order 1962* and the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 2) 1962) $\dagger$ are likely to operate in an injurious, unfair, or anomalous manner either generally to the public interest or particularly to certain industries, trades, or businesses established or carried on in New Zealand, and that certain provisions of the notes forming part of the Tariff are likely to operate in a manner that is detrimental to the proper operation of the Tariff, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 3) 1962.
(2) This order shall come into force on the lst day of July 1962.
2. The portions of the Customs Tariff specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby suspended.
3. The duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed, and the exemptions from duty in that Schedule are hereby created.
4. The notes and headings to the Tariff, and to the Divisions, Groups, and items of the Tariff, specified in the Third Schedule hereto are hereby amended in the manner indicated in that Schedule.
5. The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 2) 1962 is hereby consequentially amended by revoking (as from the commencement of that order) item 653.620.7 in the Second Schedule thereto.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.
This order corrects anomalies, obscurities, and errors in the new Customs Tariff, as set out in the First Schedule to the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961.

The order will come into force on 1 July 1962, at the same time as the new Tariff, so that the Tariff will operate as amended by the Customs Tariff Amendment Order 1962 (S.R. 1962/68) and by the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 2) 1962 (S.R. 1962/92) and by this order.

Clause 2 suspends the portions of the Tariff set out in the First Schedule.
Clause 3 substitutes the Tariff items set out in the Second Schedule.
Clause 4 makes corrections in and additions to certain notes and headings to the Tariff, the amendments being shown in the Third Schedule.

Clause 5 consequentially amends the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 2) 1962.
Schedules: In the Second Schedule some of the headings and subheadings to the Tariff items have been altered; but where items only have been altered the existing headings and subheadings (if any) relevant to those items have been included in the First and Second Schedules for the purposes of reference.
