THE CUSTOMS TARIFF AMENDMENT ORDER (NO. 3) 1969

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 17th day of February 1969

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 10E of the Tariff and Development Board Act 1961 and section 124 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the rates of duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, being rates specified in the Customs Tariff (as set out in the Second Schedule to the Customs Act 1966 and heretofore modified), are likely to operate in an injurious, unfair, or anomalous manner in respect of an industry carried on in New Zealand, and that it is necessary for the protection of that industry that the duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto should be imposed, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 3) 1969.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The portions of the Customs Tariff specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby suspended.

3. The duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed, and the exemptions from duty in that Schedule are hereby created.

4. (1) The New Zealand – Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 2) 1967* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to item 82.04.17.

(2) The New Zealand – Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 3) 1967† is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to item 82.04.12.

(3) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 12) 1968‡ is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to items 82.04.16 and 82.04.21.
