

THE CUSTOMS TARIFF AMENDMENT ORDER (NO. 3) 1971

Pursuant to sections 123 and 125 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 3) 1971.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Tariff amended—(1) The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.
- (2) The Tariff is hereby further amended in the manner indicated in the Third Schedule hereto.
- (3) Part II of the Tariff is hereby further amended by adding Reference No. 34.0, as set out in the Fourth Schedule hereto.
 - (4) The Tariff is hereby further amended by revoking item 90.08.07
- **3.** Consequential revocations—(1) The New Zealand Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 3) 1967* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to Chapter 22.
- (2) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 3) 1970† is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to item 22.09.01.
- (3) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 17) 1970‡ is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Schedule as relates to items 55.09.07 and 55.09.08.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order reduces duties on tyrecord fabrics of unbleached cotton fabrics containing

man-made discontinuous fibres and weighing more than 5½ oz per sq. yd.

It also deletes from the Tariff the provisions for assessing duties on certain alcoholic liquors on a "reputed" quantity basis and corrects a minor grammatical error in Reference 25.1 of Part II of the Tariff.

Provision has also been made for duty-free entry of imports of relief consignments for use by victims of disasters.

The order also revokes item 90.08.07.
