## THE CUSTOMS TARIFF AMENDMENT ORDER (NO. 4) 1963

BERNARD FERGUSSON, Governor-General

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 28th day of August 1963

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Customs Amendment Act 1921 and sections 5 and 6 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the rates of duty and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, being rates and exemptions specified in the Customs Tariff (as set out in the First Schedule to the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961 and heretofore modified) are likely to operate in an injurious, unfair, or anomalous manner either generally to the public interest or particularly to certain industries, trades, or businesses established or carried on in New Zealand, and that certain provisions of the notes forming part of the Tariff are likely to operate in a manner that is detrimental to the proper operation of the Tariff, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 4) 1963.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The portions of the Customs Tariff specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby suspended.

3. The duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed, and the exemptions from duty in that Schedule are hereby created.

4. The notes and headings to the Tariff specified in the Third Schedule hereto are hereby amended in the manner indicated in that Schedule.

5. (1) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order 1962\* is hereby consequentially amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to Group 053, item 629.980.4, and items 663.820.1, 663.820.2, and 663.820.9.

(2) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 3) 1962† is hereby consequentially amended by revoking so much of the Third Schedule as relates to Division 58.

(3) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 5) 1962‡ is hereby consequentially amended by revoking so much of the Schedule as relates to items 641.225.3 and 641.225.4.

(4) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 2) 1963§ is hereby consequentially amended by revoking so much of the Third Schedule as relates to Group 897.

6. (1) Except as provided in subclause (2) of this clause, this order shall be in force in the Cook Islands.

(2) So much of the First Schedule hereto as relates to Group 841 and items 899.330.1 to 899.330.9, and so much of the Second Schedule hereto as relates to Group 841 and items 899.330.1 to 899.330.5, shall not be in force in the Cook Islands.

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order makes miscellaneous alterations in the Customs Tariff.

Clause 2 suspends the portions of the Tariff set out in the First Schedule.

Clause 3 substitutes the Tariff items set out in the Second Schedule.

Clause 4 amends certain notes and headings of the Tariff, the amendments being shown in the Third Schedule.

Clause 5 consequentially amends previous Customs Tariff Amendment Orders.

Clause 6 applies this order to the Cook Islands (except as to the Group and items referred to in subclause 2, which are dealt with in the Cook Islands Customs Duties Order 1962, Amendment No. 1).
