ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 16th day of December 1974

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 124 and 125 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the rates of duty and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, being rates and exemptions specified in the Customs Tariff, are likely to operate in an injurious, unfair, or anomalous manner generally to the public interest and particularly to certain industries carried on in New Zealand, and that it is necessary for the protection of those industries that the duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto should be imposed, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Composite) Amendment Order (No. 4) 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Portion of Tariff suspended—The portion of the Customs Tariff specified in the First Schedule hereto is hereby suspended.

3. Duties imposed and exemptions created—The duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed, and the exemptions from duty in that Schedule are hereby created.

4. Consequential revocations—The Customs Tariff (Consolidation) Amendment Order 1974* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to item 71.02.302.

Customs Tariff (Composite) Amendment Order 1974/307
(No. 4) 1974

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order—

- (a) Amends the rates of Customs duty on mushrooms (headings 07.01, 07.04, and 20.02), terpineol (item 59.05.003) and unworked greenstone and thelike (item 71.02.302); and
- (b) Amends the Tariff to enable separate import statistics to be obtained in respect of battery chargers having an output of less than 10 amperes for batteries not exceeding 12 volts (heading 85.01).

These amendments were recommended by the Tariff and Development Board.
