ORDER IN COUNGIL
At the Government House at Wellington this 14th day of November
Present:
His Excellency the Governor-General in Coungil
Pursuant to section 12 of the Customs Amendment Act 1921 and sections 5 and 6 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the duties specified in the Customs Tariff (as set out in the First Schedule to the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961* and heretofore amended $\dagger$ ) are likely to operate in an injurious, unfair, or anomalous manner either generally to the public interest or particularly to certain industries, trades, or businesses established or carried on in New Zealand, and that certain provisions of the notes forming part of the Tariff are likely to operate in a manner that is detrimental to the proper operation of the Tariff, hereby makes the following order.

## OR D ER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 6) 1962.
(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
2. The portions of the Customs Tariff specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby suspended.
3. The duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed, and the exemptions from duty in that Schedule are hereby created.
4. The notes and headings to the Tariff, and to the Divisions, Groups, and items of the Tariff, specified in the Third Schedule hereto are hereby amended in the manner indicated in that Schedule.
5. The Customs Tariff Amendment Order 1962* is hereby consequentially amended-
(a) By revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to Group 541 , items $678.300 .8,678,500.6$ to 678.500 .9 , and 678.501 .1 , and Group 724:
(b) By revoking so much of the Third Schedule as relates to Division 11 and to Division 67.
6. The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 2) 1962 $\dagger$ is hereby consequentially amended-
(a) By revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to item 841.250.4:
(b) By revoking so much of the Third Schedule as relates to paragraph (c) of note 2 to Group 656.
7. The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 3) 1962 $\ddagger$ is hereby consequentially amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to item 861.990.0.
8. This order shall be in force in the Cook Islands.

' 2 . In items 812.420 .1 to 812.420 .9 , a reference to parts of articles is in no case to be taken as applying to the undermentioned goods of iron or steel nor to similar articles of other base metals, classified in Division 69:
"(a) Stranded wire, cables, cordage, ropes, plaited bands, slings, and the like;
"(b) Nails, tacks, staples, and the like;
"(c) Chain and parts thereof;
"(d) Bolts and nuts (including bolt ends and screw studs), whether or not threaded or tapped, and screws (including screw hooks and screw rings) ; rivets, cotters, cotter-pins, washers, spring washers;
"(e) Springs and leaves for springs."

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.
This order corrects anomalies, obscurities, and errors in the Customs Tariff.
Clause 2 suspends the portions of the Tariff set out in the First Schedule.
Clause 3 substitutes the Tariff items set out in the Second Schedule.
Clause 4 makes corrections in and additions to certain notes and headings to the Tariff, the amendments being shown in the Third Schedule.

Clauses 5 to 7 consequentially amend previous Customs Tariff Amendment Orders. Clause 8 applies this order to the Cook Islands.
Schedules: In the Second Schedule some of the headings and subheadings to the Tariff items have been altered; but where items only have been altered the existing headings and subheadings (if any) relevant to those items have been included in the First and Second Schedules for the purposes of reference.
