Pursuant to section 125 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 6) 1971.
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1971.
- 2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the item and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items and exemptions from duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

This order amends the Customs Tariff to enable separate import statistics to be obtained for colouring matter containing more than 50 percent by weight of titanium dioxide.
