PURSUANT to section 125 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 7) 1970.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by omitting from item 92.07.01 the words “Electronic organs”, and substituting the word “Organs”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order amends the wording of an item in the Customs Tariff thereby making provision for the classification of all electro-magnetic, electrostatic, electronic and similar electrical organs in one tariff item.

It does not alter any rates of Customs duty.
