ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 4th day of May 1970

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 125 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 9) 1970.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the item and rates of duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items and rates of duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

3. Consequential revocation—The New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 2) 1970* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to Chapter 20.
