HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 123 and 125 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 9) 1972.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1972.

2. Tariff amended—(1) The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

(2) The Tariff is hereby amended in the manner indicated in the Third Schedule hereto.

3. Revocations—(1) The New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order 1972* is hereby consequentially amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to items 60.01.019, 60.01.031, 60.01.041, 60.01.049, 60.01.051, and 60.01.059.

(2) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 17) 1970† and the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 7) 1971‡ are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order makes miscellaneous alterations to the Customs Tariff. The Second Schedule provides a number of new items under headings 58.04 and 60.01 for fabrics composed of textile fibres or yarns tufted into woven or knitted fabrics respectively. These fabrics are presently classified in Tariff item 58.10.000. Further, it corrects a drafting error relating to New Zealand's obligations under the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement. In addition, two existing Tariff items are sub-divided to enable the collection of more detailed statistical data.

The Third Schedule corrects minor printing and drafting errors, provides two new statistical units, and clarifies the context of Part II Reference 32.0.

The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 17) 1970 and the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 7) 1971 which are spent are revoked by this order.
