
### ORDER

2. Portion of Tariff suspended—The portion of the Customs Tariff specified in the First Schedule hereto is hereby suspended.


**3. Duties imposed and exemption created**—The duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed and the exemption from duty in that Schedule is hereby created.
