PURSUANT to section 125 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Developing Country) Amendment Order 1985.
 - (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on 1 July 1985.
- 2. Tariff amended—Part II of the Customs Tariff is hereby amended by inserting, before reference number 70, the reference number 65 and the description and rates of duty specified in the Schedule to this order.

This order allows Brunei and Singapore to continue to enjoy the Part I DC rates for specific tariff items by adding a new Reference Number 65 to Part II of the Tariff.
