HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Customs Tariff Classification Opinion Fees Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Tariff Classification Opinion Fees Regulations 1988* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force 28 days after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- **2. Fees for Tariff classification opinions**—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—
 - (a) By omitting from subclause (2) the expression "\$143", and substituting the expression "\$79.20".
 - (b) By omitting from subclause (3) the expression "\$39", and substituting the expression "\$33".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after the date of their notification in the Gazette, reduce the fees payable when Customs tariff classification opinions are sought.
