## THE CITRUS TREES DISEASES REGULATIONS 1969

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 28th day of April 1969

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Citrus Trees Diseases Regulations 1969.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1969.

**2. Removal of citrus plants, etc.**—Except with the consent of the Director-General of Agriculture, no person shall remove or cause to be removed any citrus plant (other than citrus fruit), or any citrus seed intended for propagation, or any plant capable of being used as a root stock for citrus plants, from any place in New Zealand outside the area hereinafter specified into that area, being the area which at the time of these regulations coming into force comprises—

- (a) The Provincial District of Auckland;
- (b) The County of Hawke's Bay;
- (c) That part of the County of Wairoa lying outside the Provincial District of Auckland;
- (d) Every city and borough surrounded by or contiguous to the County of Hawke's Bay or that part of the County of Wairoa lying outside the Provincial District of Auckland.

**3. Revocation**—The Citrus Trees Diseases Regulations 1961\* are hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations revoke the Citrus Trees Diseases Regulations 1961, and forbid the removal of any citrus plant, citrus seed for propagation, or any root stock for citrus plants, from any place in New Zealand outside the area specified in these regulations into that area.
