PURSUANT to the Chattels Transfer Act, 1924, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Chattels Transfer Fees Order (No. 3) 1951.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
2. The fees to be taken under the Chattels Transfer Act, 1924, shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto.
3. The Chattels Transfer Fees Order (No. 2) 1951* is hereby revoked.
