ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 7th day of March 1988

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 19A of the Chattels Transfer Act 1924, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Chattels Transfer Fees Regulations 1988.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 11th day of April 1988.

2. Fees—There shall be paid to the Registrar for the various matters set out in the Schedule hereto the respective fees set out in that Schedule.

3. Goods and services tax included—The fees prescribed by these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

4. Revocations—(1) The Chattels Transfer Fees Regulations 1987* are hereby consequentially revoked.

(2) The Fees Regulations 1987* are hereby amended by revoking so much of the Schedule as relates to the Chattels Transfer Fees Regulations 1987.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 11 April 1988, prescribe a new scale of fees payable under the Chattels Transfer Act 1924 to Registrars.

The fees prescribed are inclusive of goods and services tax.
