# ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 2nd day of September 1991

### Present:

THE RIGHT HON. J. B. BOLGER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 19A of the Chattels Transfer Act 1924, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Chattels Transfer Fees Regulations 1991.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 8th day of October 1991.
- 2. Fees—There shall be paid to the Registrar for the various matters set out in the Schedule hereto the respective fees set out in that Schedule.
- **3. Goods and services tax included**—The fees prescribed by these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.
- **4. Revocation**—The Chattels Transfer Fees Regulations 1988\* are hereby consequentially revoked.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 8 October 1991, prescribe a new scale of fees payable under the Chattels Transfer Act 1924 to Registrars.

The fee for searching an instrument is increased from \$3 to \$4.

The fee for each sheet of a copy of or an extract of or from any document is increased from \$1 to \$3.

The fee for filing any application for an order under section 13 of the Chattels Transfer Act 1924 is increased from \$60 to \$100.

The fees prescribed are inclusive of goods and services tax.
