At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 4th day of December, 1940.

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to subsection (6) of section 57 of the Chattels Transfer Act, 1924, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that a practice has been established of dealing with the chattels or classes of chattels described or defined in the Schedule hereto by the method of hire purchase, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Chattels Transfer (Customary Hire Purchase) Order 1940.

2. The chattels or classes of chattels described or defined in the Schedule hereto are hereby added to the class of chattels defined in the Seventh Schedule to the said Act.

3. This Order in Council shall come into force on the day following notification of the making thereof in the *Gazette*.

Electric washing-machines. Electric ironing-machines. Electric floor-polishing machines. Petrol-driven washing-machines.
