

THE CHATTELS TRANSFER (CUSTOMARY HIRE PURCHASE) ORDER 1957

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to subsection (6) of section 57 of the Chattels Transfer Act 1924, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and being satisfied that a practice has been established of dealing with the class of chattels described in the Schedule hereto by the method of hire purchase, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. (1) This order may be cited as the Chattels Transfer (Customary Hire Purchase) Order 1957.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. The class of chattels described in the Schedule hereto is hereby added to the class of chattels described in the Seventh Schedule to the Chattels Transfer Act 1924.

SCHEDULE

TANKS, equipment, apparatus, and appliances for use in connection with the storage, pumping, and serving of beer (excluding barrels).
