



**THE CHATTELS TRANSFER (CUSTOMARY HIRE
PURCHASE) ORDER 1969**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 16th day of June 1969

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to subsection (6) of section 57 of the Chattels Transfer Act 1924, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that it is desirable in the public interest that the practice of dealing by the method of hire purchase should become established in respect of the class of chattels described in the Schedule hereto, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Chattels Transfer (Customary Hire Purchase) Order 1969.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. New class of customary chattels—The class of chattels described in the Schedule hereto is hereby added to the classes of chattels described in the Seventh Schedule to the Chattels Transfer Act 1924.

SCHEDULE

Equipment, apparatus, and appliances for use in connection with the consumption of any gas, being coal gas, natural gas, water gas, gas derived from any petroleum feed-stock, or a mixture of any of those gases, obtained from a main owned or operated by a company within the meaning of the Gas Supply Act 1908.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order adds equipment, apparatus, and appliances for use in connection with the consumption of any gas, being coal gas, natural gas, water gas, gas derived from any petroleum feed-stock, or a mixture of any of those gases, obtained from a main owned or operated by a company within the meaning of the Gas Supply Act 1908 to the classes of chattels described in the Seventh Schedule to the Chattels Transfer Act 1924. This means that customary hire purchase agreements, which do not require to be registered, may be entered into under section 57 of that Act in respect of the new class of chattels.
