PURSUANT to section 125 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Temporary Importation) Amendment Order 1978.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day of February 1978.

2. Tariff amended—Part II (Concessions) of the Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking reference numbers 36.0 and 37.0, and the descriptions and rates of duty to which those numbers relate, and inserting the reference number, description, and rates of duty or exemptions from duty, specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. Consequential revocations—The Customs Tariff (Professional and Display Equipment) Amendment Order 1977* is hereby revoked.
