**THE CLOTHING TRADE LABOUR LEGISLATION SUSPENSION  
ORDER 1940, AMENDMENT NO. 1.**

WHEREAS it appears to me to be expedient for maintaining supplies and services essential to the life of the community, I, Patrick Charles Webb, Minister of Labour, pursuant to the Labour Legislation Emergency Regulations 1940, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Clothing Trade Labour Legislation Suspension Order 1940, Amendment No. 1.

2. This Order shall be read together with and deemed part of the Clothing Trade Labour Legislation Suspension Order 1940 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

3. The principal Order is amended by adding thereto the following additional clause:—

“ 6. The rates of remuneration prescribed by this Order shall be increased by an amount equal to 5 per cent. thereof.”

4. This Order shall come into effect on and from the 12th day of August, 1940.
