THE CONTAINER TERMINALS (AUCKLAND) ORDER 1977

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 11th day of July 1977

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Waterfront Industry Act 1976, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Container Terminals (Auckland) Order 1977.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Fergusson Container Terminal—(1) The land described in the First Schedule hereto, and the wharves, buildings, and other structures on that land, being land, wharves, buildings, and other structures within wharf limits at the Port of Auckland, are hereby declared to be a container terminal for the purposes of the Waterfront Industry Act 1976.

(2) The container terminal declared by subclause (1) of this clause shall be known as the Fergusson Container Terminal.

3. Mount Wellington Temporary Inland Container Terminal—(1) The land described in the Second Schedule hereto, and the buildings on that land, being land and buildings outside the wharf limits of any port, are hereby declared to be an inland container terminal for the purposes of the Waterfront Industry Act 1976.

(2) The inland container terminal declared by subclause (1) of this clause shall be known as the Mount Wellington Temporary Inland Container Terminal.

FIRST SCHEDULE

FERGUSSON CONTAINER TERMINAL

ALL that piece of land situated within wharf limits at the Port of Auckland, containing 19.62 hectares, more or less, and being more particularly shown on Drawing K442/01, a copy of which drawing is deposited in the Head Office of the Waterfront Industry Commission at Wellington.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Cl. 3

MOUNT WELLINGTON TEMPORARY INLAND CONTAINER TERMINAL

ALL that piece of land situated in Morrin Road, Mount Wellington, containing 2 acres 3 roods 16.2 perches, more or less, being Lot 2 on Deposited Plan 62089, and being part Allotments 12 and 13, Section 2, Small Lots near Village of Panmure, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title No. 19B/496, North Auckland Registry.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order declares two container terminals at Auckland to be container terminals for the purposes of the Waterfront Industry Act 1976.

Certain classes of work performed at the Mount Wellington Temporary Inland Container Terminal declared by this order will become work within the waterfront industry by virtue of this order and the Waterfront Industry Tribunal will have jurisdiction in respect of that work.
