# THE CATTLE TUBERCULOSIS REGULATIONS 1958, AMENDMENT NO. 2

# COBHAM, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 20th day of January 1960

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Stock Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Cattle Tuberculosis Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Cattle Tuberculosis Regulations 1958\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definitions of the terms "clinical case of tuberculosis" and

"reactor", and substituting the following definitions:

"'(Clinical case of tuberculosis', in relation to any cattle, means—
"(a) Any animal the appearance of which, in the opinion of any Tuberculin Testing Officer or other Inspector, justifies a diagnosis of tuberculosis in respect of that animal without the necessity for a tuberculin test; and

"(b) Any other animal the health or condition of which, in the opinion of any Tuberculin Testing Officer or other Inspector, indicates that the animal is likely to be affected with tuberculosis, and which, solely for the purpose of confirm-

ing that opinion, is tested with the tuberculin test:

"'Reactor', in relation to any cattle, means any animal which gives a positive reaction to a tuberculin test, not being a tuberculin test made in respect of a clinical case of tuberculosis, and which, in the opinion of the Tuberculin Testing Officer who tested the animal, is affected with tuberculosis:".
