PURSUANT to sections 123 and 124 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Motor Vehicles) Amendment Order (No. 2) 1988.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1988.

2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking so much of Part I as relates to item 9401.90.09, and substituting the items, rates of duty, and statistical keys specified in the Schedule to this order.
