PURSUANT to sections 123 and 124 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

# **ORDER**

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Motor Vehicles) Amendment Order (No. 2) 1988.
  - (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1988.
- 2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking so much of Part I as relates to item 9401.90.09, and substituting the items, rates of duty, and statistical keys specified in the Schedule to this order.
