THE CUSTOMS TARIFF (STRANDED WIRE AND THE LIKE,
OF ALUMINIUM) AMENDMENT ORDER 1974

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 10th day of June 1974

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 124 of the Customs Act 1966, and section 11 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the rates of duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, being rates specified in the new Customs Tariff, are likely to operate in an injurious, unfair, or anomalous manner in respect of industries carried on in New Zealand, and that it is necessary for the protection of those industries that the duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto should be imposed, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Stranded Wire and the Like, of Aluminium) Amendment Order 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1974.

2. Portion of Tariff suspended—The portion of the Customs Tariff (as set out in the First Schedule to the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1974), specified in the First Schedule hereto is hereby suspended.

3. Duties imposed and exemptions created—The duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed, and the exemptions from duty in that Schedule are hereby created.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order relates to aluminium stranded wire, cables, cordage, and plaited bands. It reinstates in the new Customs Tariff which is to come into force on 1 July 1974 the exemptions from duty which apply in the present Customs Tariff to Australia, Canada, and Commonwealth preference countries.
