PURSUANT to section 341 of the Companies Act 1955 and the Judicature Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and with the concurrence of the Right Honourable the Chief Justice and at least two of the other members of the Rules Committee (of whom at least one was a Judge of the High Court), hereby makes the following rules.

RULES

1. Title and commencement—(1) These rules may be cited as the Companies (Winding Up) Rules 1956, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read

together with and deemed part of the Companies (Winding Up) Rules 1956* (hereinafter referred to as the principal rules).

(2) These rules shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1986.

2. Interpretation—Rule 2 (1) of the principal rules is hereby amended by inserting, after the definition of the term "Court", the following definition:

"'High Court Rules' means the rules from time to time set out in the Second Schedule to the Judicature Act 1908:".

3. Orders—Rule 7 of the principal rules is hereby amended by omitting the words "Code of Civil Procedure", and substituting the words "High Court Rules".

4. Service—Rule 11 (2) of the principal rules is hereby amended by omitting the words "Code of Civil Procedure", and substituting the words "High Court Rules".

5. Application of existing procedure—Rule 192 of the principal rules is hereby amended by omitting the words "Code of Civil Procedure", and substituting the words "High Court Rules".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the rules, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These rules, which come into force on 1 January 1986, amend the Companies (Winding Up) Rules 1956 by omitting references to the Code of Civil Procedure, and substituting references to the High Court Rules. The new High Court Rules come into force on that date.
