



**THE DEFENCE AREAS (FARMING) EMERGENCY
REGULATIONS 1944**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE HON. D. G. SULLIVAN PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Defence Areas (Farming) Emergency Regulations 1944.

2. The Minister of Lands shall have the following powers in respect of any land purchased, acquired, set apart, or held in any manner by the Crown for defence purposes and not for the time being required for those purposes :—

- (a) Power to carry on farming operations in such manner as he deems expedient, and to incur any expenditure incidental to or in connection with the general development, farming, or cultivation of any such land, and the production, treatment, storage, or marketing of any crops or produce from any such land :
- (b) Power to purchase stock, chattels, implements, manures, or other materials or things which he may deem necessary for the proper farming of any such land :
- (c) Power to sell stock, chattels, implements, materials, crops, produce, or other things purchased or produced in connection with the farming of any such land :
- (d) Power to enter into such contracts as appear to him to be necessary to enable him to exercise any of the foregoing powers.

3. All rights and liabilities in respect of any contract entered into by the Minister pursuant to these regulations, and all benefit and advantage under any such contract and all interest therein, shall vest in his successor or successors in office without the necessity of any transfer or assignment whatsoever.
