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**THE DRAINAGE AND PLUMBING EXTENSION NOTICE 1950  
NO. 2**

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Department of Health,  
Wellington, 6th November, 1950.

PURSUANT to section 133 of the Health Act, 1920, and pursuant to regulations made under that Act on the 3rd day of September, 1923, and to be cited as the Drainage and Plumbing Regulations,\* I, Jack Thomas Watts, Minister of Health, hereby give notice as follows:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Drainage and Plumbing Extension Notice 1950, No. 2.

2. This notice shall take effect on the 1st day of December, 1950.

3. The Drainage and Plumbing Regulations aforesaid are hereby applied to the Waimarino County and to the Havelock Town District.

4. The Drainage and Plumbing Extension Consolidation Notice 1950† is accordingly amended as follows:—

(a) Part III of the Second Schedule thereto is amended by inserting therein, next following the reference “The Mosstown Riding of the Waitotara County” under the heading “Palmerston North Health District”, the following additional item:—

“Waimarino (the whole county) . . . 1st December, 1950.”

(b) Part III of the said Second Schedule is further amended by inserting therein, next following the second reference to portions of the County of Marlborough under the heading “Nelson Health District”, the following additional item:—

“That portion of the Marlborough County comprising the Town District of Havelock . . . . . 1st December, 1950.”
