THE DRAINAGE AND PLUMBING REGULATIONS EXTENSION ORDER 1938, NO. 1.

Department of Health,
Wellington, 3rd February, 1938.

PURSUANT to section 133 of the Health Act, 1920, and pursuant to regulations to be cited as the Drainage and Plumbing Regulations, made under that Act on the 3rd day of September, 1923,* I, Peter Fraser, Minister of Health, do hereby give notice as follows.

NOTICE.

1. This notice may be cited as the Drainage and Plumbing Regulations Extension Order 1938, No. 1.
2. The Drainage and Plumbing Regulations are hereby applied to the boroughs, county, and portions of a county set out in the Schedule hereto.
3. This notice shall take effect on the 1st day of March, 1938.
