THE DENTISTS ADVERTISING REGULATIONS 1970, AMENDMENT NO. 1

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dental Act 1963, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dentists Advertising Regulations 1970, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dentists Advertising Regulations 1970* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Metric conversions—The principal regulations are hereby amended by—

- (a) Omitting from regulation 4 (3) the expression "2 in.", and substituting the expression "5.5 centimetres":
- (b) Omitting from regulation 6 (4) (b) the expression "2 square feet", and substituting the expression "1,900 square centimetres":
- (c) Omitting from the said regulation 6 (4) (b) the expression "3 square feet", and substituting the expression "2,800 square centimetres":
- (d) Omitting from the said regulation 6 (4) (b) the expression "1 additional square foot", and substituting the expression "950 additional square centimetres":
- (e) Omitting from regulation 6 (4) (c) the expression "2 square feet", and substituting the expression "1,900 square centimetres":

- (f) Omitting from regulation 6 (5) (b) the expression "1 square foot", and substituting the expression "950 square centimetres":
- (g) Omitting from regulation 7 (4) the expression "6 in.", and substituting the expression "15.5 centimetres".
