Pursuant to section 83 (a) (ii) of the Dental Act 1988, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the advice of the Minister of Health given after consultation by the Minister with the Dental Technicians Board, makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dental Amendment Regulations 1997, and are part of the Dental Regulations 1988* ("the principal regulations").
 - (2) These regulations come into force on 1 April 1997.
- 2. Fees-Part II of the Schedule of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Dental Regulations 1988, Amendment

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1997, increase the fees payable to the Dental Technicians Board in respect of annual practising certificates for dental technicians or clinical dental technicians.

The fees prescribed are inclusive of goods and services tax.
