New First Schedule of Principal Regulations

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Designs Amendment Regulations 1999, and are part of the Designs Regulations 1954* (“the principal regulations”).

(2) These regulations come into force on 1 July 1999.

2. Fees—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following subclause:

“(2) The fees prescribed by these regulations are exclusive of goods and services tax.”

3. New scale of fees substituted—The principal regulations are amended by revoking the First Schedule, and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule of these regulations.

4. Revocation—The Designs Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 12 are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1999, prescribe a new scale of fees in respect of various matters under the Designs Regulations 1954.

The new fee scale is considerably simplified, containing only 7 separate items as opposed to the previous 26 items for which fees were payable. As with the previous scale, the fees are GST exclusive.
