PURSUANT to the Dairy Board Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Dairy Board (Means of Determining Prices) Order 1973.

2. Means of determining prices for dairy produce other than butter—The date before which the formula or other means of determination shall be proposed by the New Zealand Dairy Board and consented to by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries and by the Minister of Finance under section 26 of the Dairy Board Act 1961 (as substituted by section 5 of the Dairy Board Amendment Act 1972) shall be the 31st day of May 1973.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order provides that the date before which the formula or other means of determination to be proposed by the New Zealand Dairy Board and consented to by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries and by the Minister of Finance under section 26 of the Dairy Board Act 1961 (as substituted by section 5 of the Dairy Board Amendment Act 1972) shall be 31 May 1973, instead of 30 November 1972 as at present provided.
