## 2 Commencement of section 23 of Dog Control Amendment Act 2003

Section 23 of the Dog Control Amendment Act 2003 comes into force on 30 September 2006.

### Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order brings into force, on 30 September 2006, section 23 of the Dog Control Amendment Act 2003. Section 23 of the Act inserts a new section 35B into the Dog Control Act 1996. New section 35B authorises the Governor-General, by Order in Council made on the recommendation of the Minister of Local Government, to impose a levy on territorial authorities in each financial year to fund the costs of maintaining the national dog control information database.
