Regulations

- 1 Title**
These regulations are the District Courts Fees (Property Law Act 2007) Amendment Regulations 2007.
- 2 Commencement**
These regulations come into force on 1 January 2008.

3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the District Courts Fees Regulations 2001.

4 Application

Regulation 3(1) is amended by revoking paragraph (b) and substituting the following paragraph:

“(b) any proceedings under section 357 of the Property Law Act 2007 (which relates to orders dispensing with, or directing the manner of, service of notices, cross-notices, or other documents).”

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the District Courts Fees Regulations 2001. They come into force on 1 January 2008.

The amendment is consequential on the Property Law Act 2007. It replaces a reference to a repealed enactment with a reference to an enactment that, with or without modification, replaces, or corresponds to, the enactment repealed.
