A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Decimal Currency Act 1964, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim as follows:

1. This proclamation may be cited as the Decimal Currency (End of Transitional Period) Proclamation 1968.

2. The transitional period defined in section 3 of the Decimal Currency Amendment Act 1965 shall end with the 31st day of May 1968.
