HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 120 of the Customs Act 1966, as amended by section 4 of the Customs Amendment Act 1971, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

 ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Developing Countries Tariff Order 1972.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Developing countries**—(1) The countries set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be developing countries for the purposes of the Customs Act 1966.

(2) The Developing Countries Tariff Order 1971 is hereby consequentially revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order deletes French Guiana, Guadeloupe, Martinique, and Reunion from the list of countries which qualify in terms of the Developing Countries Tariff. In addition this order applies that Tariff to goods imported into New Zealand which are the produce or manufacture of Bahrein, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Bulgaria, Cuba, Qatar, Romania, and the Spanish dependent territory of Spanish Sahara. Ceylon and the Trucial States are now included under their new designations of Sri Lanka and the United Arab Emirates.
