**THE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES TARIFF ORDER 1972,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 120 of the Customs Act 1966, as amended by section 4 of the Customs Amendment Act 1971, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and Commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Developing Countries Tariff Order 1972, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Developing Countries Tariff Order 1972* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Developing Countries—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by omitting from Part A the item “Republic of China (Taiwan).” and inserting, after the item “Chile.”, the item “China (Taiwan).”.

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.
China is not classified as a Developing Country, except for that part known as Taiwan.
