ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 9th day of October 1978

THE RIGHT HON. R. D. MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 120 of the Customs Act 1966 (as amended by section 3 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act (No. 2) 1977), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and Commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Developing Countries Tariff Order 1976, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Developing Countries Tariff Order, 1976* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Developing Countries—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by omitting, from Part A, the item “China (Taiwan) †” and the footnote, and substituting the item “China (including that part known as Taiwan)”.
